President's Message November 2021

I hope everyone is doing well in this uncertain time of trying to get back to normalcy and still being careful to protect yourself from exposure to the Covid virus. In addition to being vigilant against Covid, we are also in flu season and need to be cautious. And the Holiday season is upon us! This is just a lot going on, to say nothing of the current political or economic climate. Just be mindful of all the stressors we are all dealing with and take good steps to deal with it.

Since the Covid situation is easing up a bit, KUUF is finally going to start in-person services. As of Oct. 31, 2021, the Stone Chapel at Proctor Academy in Andover, NH, is open for Sunday service at 11AM. KUUF is also continuing to offer services via ZOOM, as it has been doing this last year. Those of you that choose to meet with us in person (you do have the option, if you are not comfortable meeting in person, to attend via ZOOM) will need to be masked, vaccinated, and maintain appropriate distance while in the Stone Chapel. Because of ongoing safety concerns, we will not initially be offering our traditional coffee and juice following the service.

This "Hybrid" service model is new and will have some learning curve associated with it, so be prepared for a few hiccups. We are also offering the ministers and lay speakers the option of either joining us in person or joining us virtually via the ZOOM technology. This hybrid effort allows us to maintain connection to our past members and friends as well as those that travel during the winter.
